LOCATION

WHAT GOES IN THE ALBUM


We work very close with our couples after the wedding to design a wedding album that's as special and memorable as the wedding day. Each album we design is crafted individually with impeccable attention to detail.

PREPARING FOR THE BIG DAY



WEDDING DAY TIPS:

Gather all your details before the day starts so we can photograph them. This makes the getting-ready portion of the day go by much more smoothly, and it allows us to spend more time focusing on the spontaneous moments when everyone is together.

What to bring: rings, jewelry, hair pieces, flowers, shoes, socks, cuff links, socks, letters, pictures, gifts, cultural items, invitations, programs, printed pieces, & any unique items you treasure!



An engagement session gives you the opportunity to work with your photographer before the big day. Couples are usually much more relaxed on the wedding day Here is why engagement pictures should be important to you. First, they allow you to learn how to work with your photographer and just as importantly, your photographer learns how to work with you. What you like, what you don't like, etc. Secondly, it gives you diversity with the imagery in your home. You don't want every picture to be of you in your dress and tuxedo or shot at the same time of year.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

O: WHAT SETS YOU APART FROM OTHER PHOTOGRAPHERS?

A: We take a dramatic and timeless approach to assure that the photos are intimate and relaxed. We limit the amount of posed photos and tend to think of it more as guidance. Instead of being intrusive, we allow the couple to engage with one another as they would on a regular day.

O: HOW MANY PHOTOGRAPHERS WILL BE THERE AT OUR WEDDING?

A: All of our wedding collections include two photographers and Robert Roscigno is always the primary photographer. We do not "farm out" any of our weddings so you always know who you're working with and the quality of images you are going to receive.

O: HOW LONG BEFORE WE SEE OUR PHOTOS?

A: 2 weeks after your wedding, you'll be invited to a viewing session at our studio to see the images from your special day.

O: HOW MANY IMAGES DO YOU SHOOT ON A WEDDING DAY?

A: On the average, we produce and deliver approximately 70-75 images per hour of coverage. For example, a 10 hour collection yields approximately 750 final images. These are only approximate numbers but it should give you a good idea of what to expect.

DO YOU EDIT THE IMAGES BEFORE WE SEE THEM?

Yes. All of the images are edited individually, not mass produced as a batch process. Also, we often select a few images that are edited with a signature edit to give that little extra artistic approach. Signature edits are not available as a digital file, only printed product.

HAVE MORE QUESTIONS? SEND US A MESSAGE!

O: WE'RE HAVING A DESTINATION WEDDING. DO YOU TRAVEL?

A: Yes! We love destination weddings and have been lucky enough to travel all over the world shooting weddings. In most cases, the only additional expense would be the airfare, hotel and rental car.

O: DO I HAVE TO ORDER PRINTS THROUGH YOU?

A: All artwork larger than 8x10 must be ordered through the studio. This is how we are able to control the quality of the finished artwork. If you have selected the Platinum or Black Label Collection, you may print gift size prints up to 8x10, from your digital files. We also provide you with a print release for these prints.

Q: CAN WE GIVE YOU A SHOT LIST FOR THE WEDDING DAY?

A: You may provide family configurations for formal photos taken after the ceremony. Shot lists are not accepted for other portions of the coverage. We work very close with our clients to meet their needs on the day of their wedding and we find that working off of a checklist takes away from the artistic creativity of what we do.

Q: DO YOU HAVE INSURANCE?

A: Yes. This is an important question that you should ask all of your wedding vendors as most venues require insurance.

HOW DO WE RESERVE OUR WEDDING DATE?

A retainer of \$1000 and signed contract is required in order to get your wedding day on the calendar. Your final balance is due 30 days prior to your wedding. A variety of payment options are available.



CROWD MANAGEMENT

It helps to appoint a friend or family member who can proactively gather the groups so we can focus on creating beautiful photos! Usually this person knows the groups pretty well, they have a loud voice, and they can round people up with ease.

AFTER THE CEREMONY

After the ceremony, have your officiant make an announcement asking family members to stay in the ceremony location. Have an appointed friend help facilitate the different groups you would like to have photographed.

Keep your list of groups short. Please note that each group shot can take 2-3 minutes. We would all love to have photos with every important person at the wedding, but time is of the essence. Less is more in this type of situation, and you will have the reception to get group shots, if necessary.

When these are in place, you are destined for fun & smooth formal portraits! This also allows for creative wedding party photos as well as romantic bride & groom portraits with beautiful lighting!

YOUR WEDDING: UNPLUGGED

We live in a world of visual stimulation. Facebook, Instagram, Snapchat, selfies are the norm. All too often we miss REAL moments in our attempt to record it. Everyone wants to be the first to post photos of your joyous occasion only to later realize that they missed the moment in their attempt to document it.

Your wedding day should be about family and friends celebrating with you. You want your guests to enjoy the day, and be part of it, you haven't invited your family and friends along to take photos and be a photographer for the day, you have hired a professional for that. You have invited them because you want them there, there in person and not hidden behind a phone.

HOW TO GET IT DONE:

Here are three ways to let your guests know that they can leave their camera home and their cell phone off.

1. Invitation insert.

A little card that helps to plant the idea. It's a great way to open the lines of communication, stating your wish from the very beginning.

2. Signs.

Use a sign when guests are entering the ceremony space to remind them to unplug. We've seen everything from simple DIY signs to having a sign custom made for your special day.

3. Your officiant.

Ask your officiant to make an announcement prior to the ceremony.

ALBUMS:

ARE THEY REALLY NECESSARY?

It is one thing to view your digital photos on a computer, but it is something entirely different to see, touch, and flip through pages filled with hand-picked images from your wedding day. Showing off your wedding album is a great way to entertain guests in your new home (albums also make perfect gifts for the in-laws, hint hint).

THE PROCESS:

Designing your album with us is really easy! To keep the process as smooth as possible, we provide a worksheet that helps you select images that best tell the story of your wedding. From there, we'll design your spreads and send the proof over via email. You will have the chance to make two rounds of edits to the design, if need be. Additional edits are charged accordingly (ask us for more details if you have questions about your album).











The Louvre Series album is our flagship album. Made with only the highest quality Italian leathers and binding materials. They are hand-crafted in the U.S.A. and feature intricate 8-pleat rounded corners, crushed velvet liners, silk headbands and high-quality photographic prints mounted on extra-thick pages with a lay-flat designitis the details that make the Louvre Series exceptional.

The Louvre Series albums are available in seven different sizes (10x10, 12x12, 11x16 storybook, 16x11, 12x18 storybook, 18x12 and 20x8) and are available in 45 different colors/textures.

The Prado Series album is featured in our Platinum Photography Collection. Like it's big brother, the Louvre Series, it's also hand-crafted with Italian leather. They are made in the U.S.A. and also feature the 8-pleat rounded corner design and high-quality photographic prints mounted on thick lay-flat pages. The Prado Series album comes with a black paper liner.

The Prado Series album is only available in one size (10x10) and only comes in one color, black leather. The album comes standard with twenty pages but additional pages can be added (up to 70 pages).
